THREE INGREDIENT PEACH COBLER

INGREDIENTS:

- 1 Box of yellow cake mix
- 29 oz can of peaches
- ½ cup of butter
- Optional cinnamon or sugar

INSTRUCTIONS:

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 Degrees C).

Optional: Spray baking dish with nonstick spray

Step 1 Dump half of your cake mix into the bottom of your baking dish.

Step 2 Pour your peaches and the syrup over the cake mix.

Step 3 Mix the peaches and the cake mix around until the mix and the peach syrup has combined.

Step 4 Evenly Pour the rest of the cake mix on top of the dish.

Step 5 Melt your butter and put it on top of the cake mix.

Optional: Add sugar or cinnamon (or both) on top of the dish.

Step 6 Put the dish in the oven for 45-50 minutes then enjoy!
